

2018 High School Mission Trip FAQ

Burnamwood Appalachian Ministry Irvine, KY

When is the trip?

Depart from church on July 8 and return late on July 13th

What is the cost of the trip?

Your cost is \$350 but the actual cost per person will depend on number of attendees. The balance will be raised through fundraising. If our fundraising goal is not reached, the difference will be divided between the number of attendees. Goal: raise enough money to cover our cost.

What is covered in the fee?

Transportation (we rent vans), food, lodging and leadership.

Who is eligible to attend?

All high school students including, freshman entering HS in August 2018 and those graduating in May 2018.

Who are the leaders?

The number of leaders will depend on the amount of attendees. We provide one leader per 5 children and will have at least one male and one female. The leaders are all approved by the church and background checked.

Will we be working with another church?

No, during our workday we will be working on projects as a team. If enough people attend the trip we may be able to divide into teams and work on two different projects. We will have the opportunity to connect with local high school youth groups and with the students attending the night owl camp at Burnamwood the same week.

Why Burnamwood?

We wanted a work trip (light to moderate handy work) and since we had participated in the Burnamwood Appalachian Ministry in the past, we thought it was time to return. The facilities are large, the area is beautiful and the work is challenging, meaningful and needed.

How do I reserve a spot?

A \$50 deposit and your completed application is due no later than January 2. The final payment of \$300 is due April 1.

What types of fundraising will I be required to do?

We have numerous opportunities to raise funds beginning December 9 with Jesus' Birthday Party. As a team we will host two more Parent's Night Out events, the pancake breakfast, and our mission trip fundraiser through the church will be in May. The Cookie Walk donates money to our mission and in the past the Easter breakfast has donated to our work. All are required to participate in the May fundraiser and you will be required to volunteer at a minimum of one more event.

May I fundraise on my own?

Yes, you may ask family and friends outside of church to sponsor you directly. If you choose to do this we ask that the check be made to RCLPC with your name in the memo line. This money will be applied directly to the \$350 you owe and excess will be put into the general mission fund.
